PRIVACY POLICY

COMBI PACKAGING SYSTEMS, LLC (the "Company") is at all times interested in providing you with the best possible user experience. This Privacy Policy ("Privacy Policy") and the Terms of Usage ("Terms of Usage"), located at http://www.combi.com/en/CSPD/ describe how the Company handles your personal information for the services on the Company's website located at http://www.combi.com/en/CSPD/ (the "Website"). By accessing and using the Website, you are accepting and agreeing to the Privacy Policy and the Terms of Usage, and you expressly consent to the Company's collection, storage, use and disclosure of your personal information as described in this Privacy Policy and/or the Terms of Usage. Please Read This Privacy Policy Carefully.

- 1.) **Purpose.** The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to inform you about the types of information the Company might collect from you when you visit the Website, how the Company may use that information and whether the Company discloses that information to anyone. By accessing or using the Website, you expressly agree to this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy does not apply to the practices of companies that the Company does not own or control, or to individuals that are not under the Company's employ, supervision or control.
- 2.) Information Collection and Use. The Company gathers personal information about the users of the Website, which personal information is obtained when you register for an account with the Website, you purchase and/or use the products or services offered through the Website, and when you visit webpages on the Website or on websites of partners or affiliates of the Company. The Company automatically receives and records information from your computer or browser, including your IP address, cookie information, software and hardware attributes and the page(s) you request. Personal information is information about you that is personally identifiable, including but not limited to:
 - a. E-mail addresses, physical contact information, and (depending on the circumstances) possibly financial information, such as credit card or bank account numbers;
 - b. Transactional information depending on how you utilize the Website;
 - c. Information regarding pages visited, quantity of searches performed, and keyword searches;
 - d. Billing or other information you provide upon purchasing products or services from the Website;

 - g. Other information, including IP addresses and standard web log information; and

- 3.) **Information Sharing and Disclosure.** The Company does not rent, sell or share personal information about you with other people or non-affiliated companies except to provide content that you have requested, or under the following circumstances:
 - a. The Company may share personal information with its partners, sponsors, and advertisers to help them better understand the Website and services, as well as user behavior. The sharing of said information is only in the aggregate and no information specific to you is released.
 - b. The Company may disclose personal information to respond to subpoenas, court orders, or legal process, or to establish or exercise the Company's legal rights or defend against legal claims.

- c. The Company may share personal information where the Company, in its discretion, deems it necessary in order to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the physical safety or any person, violations of the Company's Terms of Usage, or as otherwise required by law.
- d. The Company may disclose personal information to enforce its policies, respond to claims that a listing or content violates the rights of others, or protect anyone's rights, property or safety.
- e. The Company may transfer personal information about you if the Company is acquired by or merged with another company, or if Company forms a division or affiliate and transfers thereto the ownership and operation of the Website. In this event, the Company will notify you before information about you is transferred and becomes subject to a different privacy policy.

The Company works with vendors, partners, advertisers, affiliates and other service providers in different industries and categories of business, including, but not limited to, the presenters/preparers of the content contained on the Website.

- 4.) **Company Communications.** The Company reserves the right to send to you, by e-mail or otherwise, communications relating to the Website and the services and products provided by the Company, including, but not limited to, service announcements and administrative messages. By registering with the Website, you are agreeing to receive such communications and the Company does not have to offer you the opportunity to opt out of receiving them.
- 5.) Minors. The Website does not collect information specific to individuals under eighteen (18) years of age and does not target such individuals as users.
